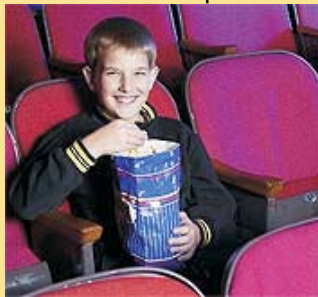

As I write this entry for the newsletter it is the day before Thanksgiving Day, so as you read this, the Holidays are all behind us. I hope that this holiday season brought you joyful times with family and friends. I also hope you

were able to partake of Club events leading up to, and including the New Year's Party. So with that said, I hope the New Year brings you happiness and good fortune.

In January, newly elected Board of Governors Members were inducted onto the Board to begin a 2-year term. I want to thank Terrie Gornet for her leadership as Chairperson of the Election Committee. Everything went off as planned. Rather than stealing Terrie's thunder, I direct you to her column in this Newsletter for the election results. At the same time, I also want to thank outgoing Board Members, Mike Ferguson, Wayne Lockett, Alan Morgan, Jeff Wiley, Dr. Brian Zale, and Hugh Boyt who have completed their commitment to represent members.

Now let me share some good news from the last Board meeting. As many of you have brought to my attention, all of SWCC locker rooms need repair. After 25 years of use, and having gone through some minor repair since, the Board agrees. Utilizing funds from the Member Capital Fund, the Club and Board approved the purchase of all the lockers from a local health club that ceased operations. Approximately 900 mahogany half-lockers with brass nameplates, and combination locks were acquired. Along with this acquisition came various other items that were deemed of value and usable at our Club. a plan for locker rooms is being written as we speak on how to accomplish these renovations in stages. The initial deployment was targeted at the ladies locker room at the Athletic Center, which recently received new carpet. This will also afford the knowledge of how to best install, and refine the technique. Men's and women's golf locker rooms as well as men's athletic rooms are targeted in due time. Thank you Frank Yonish, Member Capital Fund Committee Chair for bringing this opportunity to the Board.

As I mentioned in the last Newsletter, my term as Chairman of the Board ended at the end of the year. At the January Board meeting, a new Chairperson will be elected. I have enjoyed writing this message to share news about actions taken by the Board in an effort to keep you informed of the process. So, I now hand the message-writing pen to the new Chairperson.
